ABOUT EVOLVE TO INNOVATE

The e2i program creates a new pathway for researchers from across faculties to translate successful research outcomes into practical solutions. e2i fellows will engage in an eight-month experiential innovation curriculum, including mentorship from experienced entrepreneurial faculty members, hands-on workshops, guidance, and a cash allowance.

The e2i program prepares participants to develop the skills required to make an impact by evolving their research to pursue research translation, and confidently explore the commercial potential of existing research.

ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY

Eligible students include those from any discipline and faculty registered in a Canadian college and university who is:

- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.
- Legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- Enrolled in any full- or part-time program of post-secondary study.

You'll get matched with a newly formed company centered around research occurring at the University of Calgary for a short-term paid experience. Through an 80-hour placement, and under guidance of Innovate Calgary staff, the successful candidate will be paired with an e2i team to assess the commercial potential of the team's innovation.

Students will be required to participate in an onboarding process, complete an evaluation following completion of the program, and will be paid \$825.00 for their time.
